Student Parent Contract

- Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child arrives at school on time. Students must be in their seats by the start of class as indicated in the Student Handbook. Any student arriving after this time will receive a tardy slip. Students accumulating ten (10) unexcused tardies per school year will be referred for excessive tardiness.
- Parents must contact the school office if their child will be absent. On the day the student returns to school, they must bring a note from the parent(s) explaining the reason for the absence; otherwise, the absence will be considered unexcused.
- Parents of students not enrolled in the after-school program or after-school activities must ensure that their child is picked up by dismissal time. If a student is picked up more than fifteen (15) minutes after dismissal time, parents may be charged for supervision in the after-care program. The school will publish such rates annually in the Student Handbook.
- South Prep Scholars Academy believes that parents play an integral role in their child's educational and social life. Parents will have opportunities to engage in school activities.
- School uniforms must be worn daily. Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child wears the proper uniform as outlined in the Student Handbook. Approved jackets and sweaters, or other solid-colored outerwear in approved school colors, may be worn in cold weather. The school will advise parents of dress-down days.
- Parents are expected to provide lunch or a lunch application for their child. Students may bring lunch from home.
- Parents agree to read and use the information sent home by the school to stay informed about activities and academic opportunities.
- Parents and students are required to read the Student Handbook. This handbook outlines the responsibilities of staff, students, and parents. Failure to meet these obligations may result in corrective actions as per the school's Charter and the Florida Department of Education's guidelines.

All students enrolled in South Prep Scholars Academy are students of Miami-Dade County Public Schools and are subject to applicable policies and entitled to the same rights.

By signing this contract, I (we) agree to fulfill our contractual obligations to South Prep Scholars Academy. The full details of these obligations, as well as the possible consequences of failing to meet them, are outlined in both the Student Handbook and the MDCPS E-handbook.
